THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

THE EAST TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION was established in 1981. One of the main purposes of the Association is to provide scholarships to current seniors graduating from East Technical High School to further their education at either 1) An accredited four or two-year college/university at full-time status or 2) A trade or technical school.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, you must

- 1) Be a graduating senior from East Technical High School
- 2) Be accepted:
 - a. At an accredited four or two-year college or university or
 - b. At an accredited technical or trade school.
- 3) Have a minimum 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- 4) Display a commitment to academic performance, leadership, community service, volunteer activities and personality
- 5) Passed all required parts of the Ohio Graduation Test (OGT).
- 6) Display financial need (see ETAA Financial Information Form)

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications are available in the guidance counselor's office, Cleveland Scholarship Programs, Inc. representative office, East Technical High School Alumni Association's office (Rm. 125), or at www.easttech-alumni.org. A complete application must include:

- Scholarship Application
- High School Transcript
- An essay (see essay section of the scholarship application for details)
- Letter of acceptance from a university or trade/ technical college.

Completed applications must be postmarked by April 22, 2011

SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship Committee will base its scholarship decisions on the completed application, financial need and on evidence of commitment to academic performance, leadership community service, volunteer activities and personality. A personal interview may be requested by the Committee.

Scholarships will be awarded annually in equal amounts over a four year period for universities/colleges or two year period for continued education programs. The scholarship amounts and number of recipients are based on the performance of the Association's fundraising activities. Upon receiving the recommended recipients from the scholarship selection committee, the Alumni Finance Board will determine distribution amounts per recipient. The scholarships will be made payable to the recipient's bursar's account at their respective educational institution by the start of the academic/ technical school year. Scholarship recipients will be announced at: 1) East Tech's Annual Senior Recognition Ceremony, 2) the Association's Annual Scholarship reception and 3) showcased on the Association's website.

SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW CRITERIA

The scholarship applications will be scored using four categories. The categories and scores are as follows:

All questions answered appropriately (None Missed)	1-5 Pts.
Clarity (Descriptive, Believable, Flow)	1-5 Pts.
Personal Opinion	1-5 Pts.
Financial Need	1-5 Pts.
Attendance, Grades, Improvement (Transcripts)	1-10 Pts

Total Possible Points 30 Pts.

The applicant(s) that receive the highest scores will be awarded scholarship(s).

NOTE: Scholarship monies will ONLY be distributed to the recipient's student account at the educational institution that they will be attending.
